The Airpark surprise this month is a demand from the City to remove a cluster of dead Oak trees behind Snipe Count. A new city ordinance took effect in December of last year requiring property owners to remove nuisance dead trees. The trees at issue were killed by Oak wilt. The airpark could use a new pile of wheel chocks. We will organize a wheel chock manufacturing operation soon.

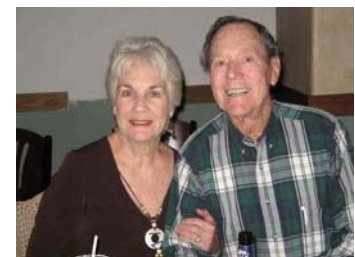

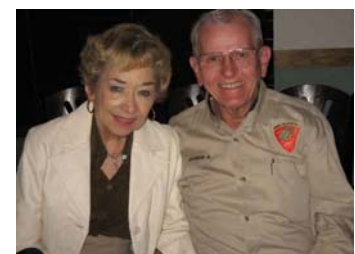

Missing are the most important of all—Bonnie & Bill Thompson—They were the ones that organized this dinner and were up greeting people and missed getting their picture taken.

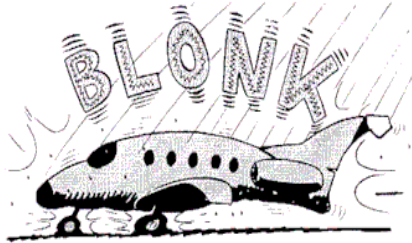
