change at any time, have proceeded. You have, or should have, received an email with new Rules. At the December meeting, the board and attending members suggested several changes. These changes have been incorporated into the most recent Rules that went out on the 26th. These new rules will be reviewed again at the January 12th board meeting. If there are no significant changes, my expectation is that the Rules will be approved.

The changes to the Bylaws will take more time. My feeling is that the Airpark is continuing to grow in many ways – membership, based aircraft, organizational complexity, and regulatory environment. The existing Bylaws serve us well, but need some adjustment to meet the challenges the Airpark will face going forward. These Bylaws changes will be done carefully, which will take some time.

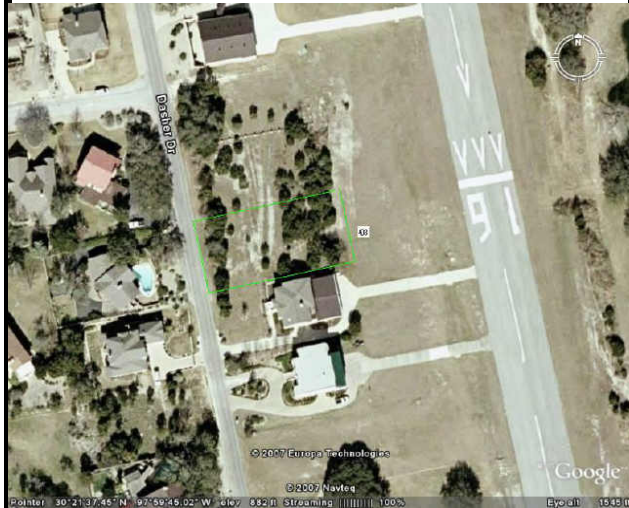
