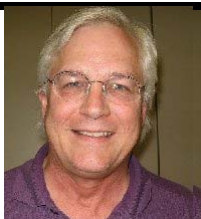

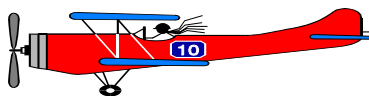


## LAKEWAY AIRPARK—WEEKEND FLYOUTS
