Wow has it been hot and windy! I stayed grounded this weekend rather than test my gusty wind handling skills. I am working on resealing a pesky oil leak. Only one flight was made since the repair and it looks good so far. So in celebration, I got some waterless hand cleaner with pumice and cleaned off all the bugs and goo that have been accumulating. With light wiping, the pumice stuff does not seem to harm the old paint and does a great job scrubbing off the accumulated bug, oil, and fuel stains. The stuff completely dries out leaving a sandy like residue that brushes or falls off.
