EAA membership: The EAA has approved the formation of a Lakeway Chapter. We need to submit the formal paperwork.

Early & Late departure policy: No update.

Deer population: Deer nets are installed and trapping is underway.

Security Camera: No progress reported.

Fuel tank recertification: Jeff Klaas has taken an online course to allow the airpark to self certify to the TCEQ. We have file for and received our certificated of compliance.

Lakeway and Lakeway Airpark 50th anniversary: No update.

New Business:

Hangar area landscaping: Mike Torbett reported that Robert White has requested the board approve work to remove grass encroachment around the taxiways in the hangar area. The board agreed to table this pending a survey of the work that was underway.
