New Business

- Hail shed discussion. Need to better track and run annual auction. We are now soliciting bids for the hail shed. Jim Quartz owns the Bonanza that is in the hail shed currently although Bob Turchan is responsible for paying for the current term and brought a check to the board meeting to cover through end of Sept. Jim Quartz’s Bonanza had a ramp lease month to month, but that ended and he did not renew his membership. Erik will contact Jim re: membership. Phil proposed to put out a bid now and try to start Oct 1st with new lease. Suggested minimum bid of \$500/month minimum. **Josh to get a note out to the membership for a lease through end of May.** Sealed Bid. Open 5pm on Sep 29th. The hail shed goes up for re-bid each year. Early April we send a new bid request out and mark April 29th to unseal the bids. Bids to go into fee box. Whoever signs the hail shed lease, if they leave or vacate, then the lease ends. A partner in a plane cannot extend it.
- Steve Smith would like to audit the number of credit cards vs members and ensure that non-members are not getting fuel discounts. **Erik offered to go through that with Steve.**
- Lynn Fisher asked to speak about the SUP that was approved on Sep 11th by Lakeway City ZAPCO for an existing office inside an existing hangar south of the Airpark and not on Airpark property. Phil explained that this was not on the agenda and had been prior addressed and closed by the Board a topic of discussion. Lynn continued to speak about her experiences and a crash 7 or 8 years ago and other items. As a courtesy the Board stayed in session and listened to her.
